



## iLaw Pro 2 Technical Specifications

Workstation, Laptop and tablets Operating system:

**OS:** MS Windows™ 7 / 8 / 8.1 & 10 (32 or 64 bit versions)

Note: Please note that Windows XP™ is no longer supported by Microsoft therefore it is incompatible with iLaw Pro 2.

Workstation hardware minimum:

**CPU:** Intel Core i3 processor or AMD Equivalent

**MEMORY:** 4Gb minimum

**DISK:** 40GB or more free space

**DISPLAY:** A minimum 1280 x 1024

Server hardware minimum:

**OS:** Windows Server™ 2008 / 2008 R2 / 2012 / 2012 R2

**CPU:** Intel Xeon E3 1220v2 or better

**MEMORY:** 8Gb

**DISK:** 1Tb

Note: An appropriate backup software and regime is required.

iMobile Tablet / Laptop Minimum:

**CPU:** Intel Core i3 or AMD Equivalent

**MEMORY:** 4Gb

**DISK:** 250GB or more free space

**DISPLAY:** A minimum 1280 x 1024

Please note that full disc encryption in MS Windows is required to be turned on. Your IT advisor will be able to advise you how to do this.

Note: If you are considering tablets to use with iLaw or iMobile, please ensure that the operating system is not Windows RT. Windows RT will not allow users to install applications directly on the tablet (which rules out full versions of MS Office and Adobe as well as iLaw) and they have different microprocessors which are incompatible with iLaw.

MS Exchange™ Server:

**MS Exchange™ Server:** 2010 with SP1, 2 or 3 / 2013

Note: iLaw Pro 2 MS Exchange integration will work with an Office 365 cloud installation of MS Exchange although the LAA and MOJ have directed that this isn't an option if you would like to integrate this with your CJSM.

MS Office™ and Adober Reader:

**MS Word™:** 2010 / 2013 / 2016 32 bit editions

Note: You must have the full version of MS Word and not a starter version.

If your copy of MS Office is provided under an Office 365 subscription plan, iLaw Pro 2 has been tested against the following editions:

- Pro Plus
- Business
- Enterprise E3

All three editions contain a downloadable edition of MS Word and this is the version that is to be installed and used with iLaw on workstations, laptops and tablets.

**Adobe Reader:** Version 11.0 or higher
